
GCSE Design and Technology



Year 11 Topics



Sequence	Description
Controlled Assessment	Students will undertake a project as part of their non-examination assessment. The project will test students' skills in investigating, designing, making and evaluating a prototype of a product that will allow them to apply the skills they have acquired and developed throughout their study. This project will require students to follow an iterative design process rather than a linear process requiring them to continually test, evaluate and refine ideas. The content and assessment criteria are set out in a linear format to show what is required at each stage of the total project, but following an iterative process students will do work on different stages at a variety of points throughout their project.
Exam Preparation and Revision	Students will revise all topics that have previously been covered; they will practice a range of exam question styles and learn to work out what is being asked of them by the question. They will learn how to plan and structure longer answers ensuring that they get the most out of each question across the whole paper.
