Bespoke provision for SEND pupils.

Topics on the Programme of study

- BSL conversations
- Reading comprehension
- Understanding and following instructions – breaking them down and discussing how to figure out what to do next.
- Deciphering timetables.
- Organisation
- Social skills including turn taking through game play.
- Auditory memory.
- Reading from the board.
- Spelling Made Easy and corrections.
- Independent reading every lesson.
- Behavioural situations and speaking to adults.
- Strategies for difficult situations
- High Frequency words assessments and moving on to testing on mistakes throughout time.
- Next 200 if and when appropriate.
- Friends and fall outs.
- Speaking and listening activities to boost confidence. Followed by presentations to the small group.
- Group novel

- Being reactive to the needs of the pupil group means that the order changes throughout the lessons.
- However a brief overview of all of the years is;
- Autumn term
 - Introductions to BSL
 - Introduction/reminders of the purpose of the lesson.
 - Focus on spelling and dictation
 - Handwriting
 - Following instructions
 - Auditory Memory
 - Spelling skills
 - Listening to instruction
 - Independent organisation of workspace
 - Discussion about starting school and behaviour etc.
 - Using online programmes to boost literacy confidence
 - Developing independence
 - Social skills and reactions to situations
 - Discussions around homework
- Spring term
 - Continue BSL Programme
 - Reminders of purpose (options discussions with Year 9 – support with forms and choices)
 - Reading focus
 - Decoding
 - Blending
 - Unfamiliar sounds

- Using programmes such as WordShark, Beat Dyslexia, Moon Dog books, Conquering Literacy etc. Depending on group's level.
- As well as Autumn term skills
- Summer term
 - Continue BSL programme
 - Reminders of purpose and discuss next year (dependant on year)
 - Breaking down test papers
 - Reading comprehension
 - Class novel and associated activities
 - Reading comprehension programme and corrections with discussion
 - 'Let's think in English' discussion tasks
 - Using Read theory online programme.

Intervention taken from a variety of research driven intervention programmes. SENDCo accesses those parts that are relevant to the pupil at the time.

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
